

## Scanning and Retouching Family Photos

As a result of many requests from students who have passed through our classroom, we have initiated a new course that will demystify the process of scanning and processing photographic prints.

This course outlines the steps involved in using a scanner to convert prints into high quality digital images. It also provides an explanation of relevant concepts such as resolution, file types, colour settings, and other scanner settings that are important to understand in order to get the best possible digital image.

Thereafter, students are given a hands-on opportunity to learn how to remove scratches, noise, stains, tears etc from these digital images by learning the many techniques, touch up tools, and procedures that Adobe Photoshop provides.

The course runs for 6 hours and is divided into two 3-hour modules. Students will be given the opportunity to scan, retouch and print 2 photos of their choice. Class size is limited to 5 students, and a high level of one-on-one assistance is provided.

Students will take away a set of notes, the prints they make, as well as a CD-Rom containing the files they worked on; several helpful image-oriented utilities; and an electronic copy of the notes that they received on course.
